

ORDINANCE 1 -2016

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PORTAGE, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA VACATING PRIOR ORDINANCE # 1-2008 WHICH PROVIDED FOR AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT RELATED TO GRANT WRITER SERVICES BETWEEN PORTAGE TOWNSHIP, PORTAGE BOROUGH, AND CASSANDRA BOROUGH, LOCATED IN CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS; Portage Township, Portage Borough, and Cassandra Borough previously entered into a formal agreement permitting each municipality to create an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement related to Grant Writer services in accordance with the provisions of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Law, Act of 1996, Dec. 19, P.L. 1158, No. 177, § 1, (53 Pa.C.S.A. § 2301 et seq.) as amended.

WHEREAS, as a result of changed circumstances, the Township deems it no longer economically beneficial to the Township to continue to participate in this Agreement and has provide written notice to the other participants on March 3, 2016, effective April 4, 2016, of the Township's termination of this Agreement.

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Ordinance is to VACATE the aforementioned Ordinance #1-2008, in its entirety.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PORTAGE, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: Effective immediately, the Township VACATES Ordinance #1-2008, which Ordinance provided for an agreement for Intergovernmental Cooperation known as the "INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT RELATED TO GRANT WRITER". Said Agreement was terminated by Motion dated March 2, 2016, and delivered March 3, 2016, to the other participants, effective April 4, 2016.

SECTION 2: It is the intent of the Municipality that the provisions of this Ordinance are severable and the invalidity of any Section, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall not affect or impair the validity of any other part of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid part or parts.

SECTION 3: The proper officers of the Municipality, as applicable, are authorized and directed to execute, to attest, to acknowledge and to deliver all documents, on behalf of this municipality, in the form so approved. Proper officers of this Municipality are authorized and directed to execute any and all documents and to do any and all other acts that may be necessary and proper to carry out this Ordinance and the undertakings of this municipality.

SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as same affects this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately, or as soon as legally permissible and shall remain in effect unless and until subsequently repealed or amended.
