

ORDINANCE 4 -2011

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PORTAGE, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1-2010 AND ABOLISHING THE POSITION OF TOWNSHIP MANAGER IN PORTAGE TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PORTAGE, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: Office of Township Manager Abolished.

Ordinance No. 1-2010 is hereby repealed and the office of Township Manager is hereby abolished by the Township of Portage, effective April 29, 2011. Any powers and duties previously delegated to the Township Manager shall be recalled and be vested in the Board of Supervisors.

SECTION 2: Severable Provisions.

It is the intent of the Municipality that the provisions of this Ordinance are severable and the invalidity of any Section, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall not affect or impair the validity of any other part of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid part or parts.

SECTION 3: Officers Authorized to Act. The proper officers of this Municipality are authorized and directed to execute any and all documents and to do any and all other acts that may be necessary and proper to carry out this Ordinance and the undertakings of this municipality.

SECTION 4: Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as same affects this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: Effective Immediately.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately, or as soon as legally permissible and shall remain in effect unless and until subsequently repealed or amended.
